We are currently recruiting participants for an immersive fieldwork experience in Kanchanaburi, Thailand, under the theme "**BLUEPRINTS FOR RESILIENCE: DESIGNING WITH NATURE AND PEOPLE.**"

Kanchanaburi, a province renowned for its rich history and diverse ecosystems, serves as a living laboratory where infrastructure meets the natural world. Instead of merely observing, participants will explore how human engineering can coexist sustainably with the environment.

Engage with local experts and diverse stakeholders to uncover the balance between development and conservation. Key activities include data collection and site visits at Mahidol University (Kanchanaburi Campus), observing water management and energy production at the Srinagarind Dam and Hydroelectric Power Plant, and experiencing the biodiversity of Erawan Waterfall.

Join us to design safeguards for our environment and create resilient blueprints for future generations.
